RE: REPLACEMENT OF BRIDGE D-66 OLD STATE ROUTE 22 (CR-6) OVER SWAMP RIVER, TOWN OF DOVER, DUTCHESS COUNTY

Dear Dutchess County Resident:

We are pleased to announce, as part of our continuing effort to revitalize our county road system, the Dutchess County Department of Public Works (DPW) will be replacing the bridge on Old State Route 22 (CR-6) over the Swamp River in the Town of Dover. This work is critical to improving the safety of the roadway.

Project work, which will begin on or about the week of April 18th, will include replacing the existing structure with a new, wider bridge to incorporate 4-foot shoulders and widen the travel lanes to match the approach roadway. The portion of Old State Route 22 near the project, located between the intersections of Jordyn Lane and Sherman Hill Road, will be closed with a detour posted along Lime Kiln Road, Maple Lane, Mill Street, and State Route 22. A map of the detour is enclosed. It is anticipated the project will be complete, with the new bridge open to traffic, by the end of this year.

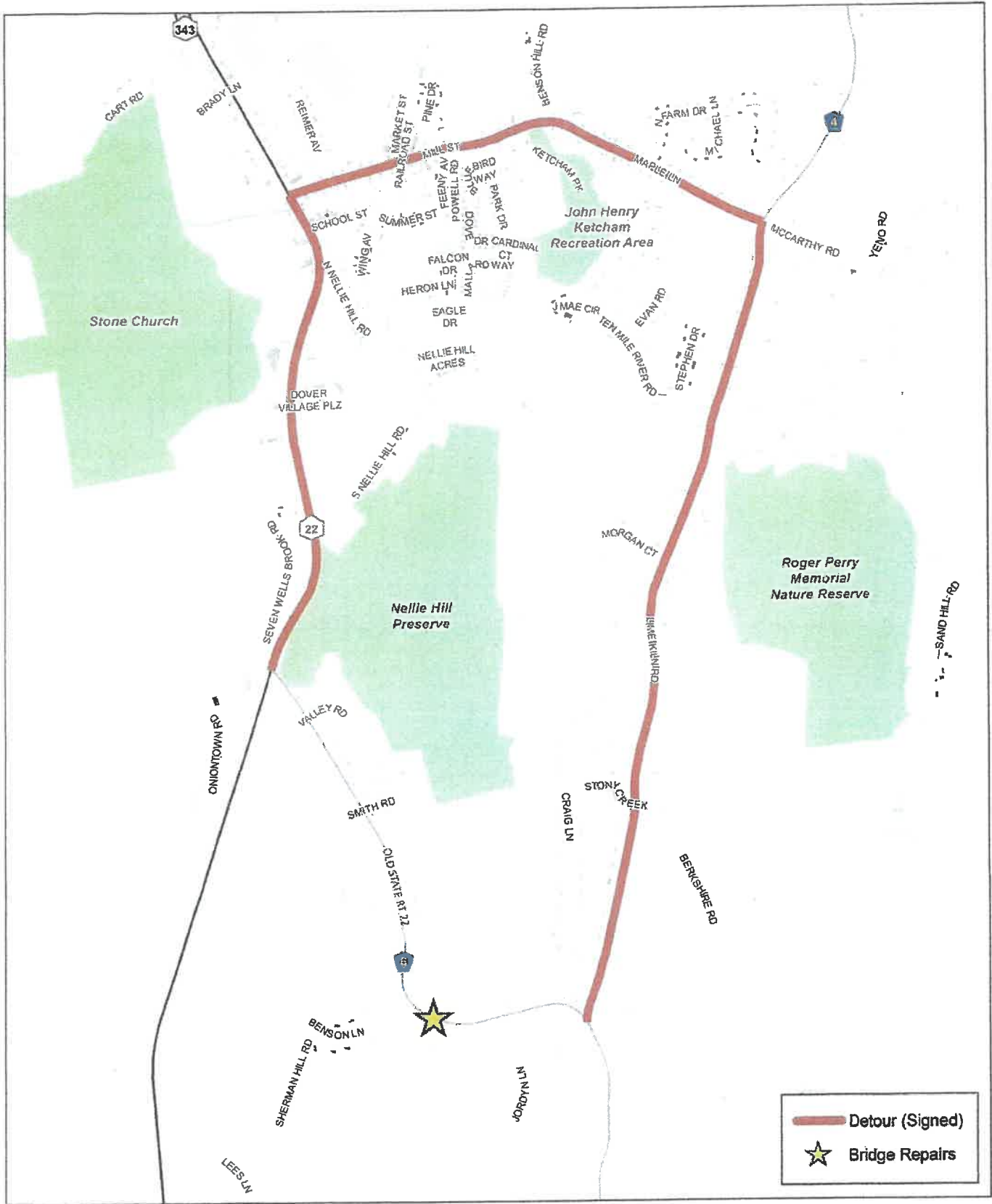
