Projects/Work Completed or Ongoing in 2020:

- Achieved Bronze-level certification in the NYS Climate Smart Communities Program (Sept. 2020)
- Completed a town-wide upgrade of Town Streetlight District lighting with LED fixtures (April 2020)
- Completed data collection and visioning work on a NYS DEC CSC grant-funded Sustainability
 Element for the Town's Comprehensive Plan Update
- Participated in the ongoing intermunicipal Ten Mile River Watershed Collaborative to assist with development of a Ten Mile River Watershed Management Plan (identified Town goals for plan)
- Applied to the Charge Ready NY Program to Install an Public Electric Vehicle Charging Station at a town-owned facility
- Helped the Town Board apply for a Dutchess County CDBG grant for town parks improvement project to construct a ¼ porous pavement walking track to provide an sustainable public amenity
- Helped the Town apply/receive a grant from Hudson River Valley Greenway Communities Program
 for a consultant to review the draft Comprehensive Plan Update to help strengthen the draft
 plan's inclusion of Greenway Communities Compact principles
- Assisted the Town-FrOGS initiative to transfer a 6.3 acres tax-delinquent parcel in the Great
 Swamp held in rem proceedings to the Friends of the Great Swamp for permanent conservation
- Supported the Town's successful application to the Dutchess County's Partnership for Manageable Growth Program to acquire approx. 170 acres of land adjacent to the Dover Stone Church for permanent conservation (Seven Wells- a significant aquifer recharge for 1000+ customer water system of the Dover Plains hamlet and surrounding neighborhoods with private wells.
