- created and maintain a pollinator garden at J. H. Ketcham Memorial Park in Dover Plains planted with assistance of local Girl Scouts
- continued development of a sustainability chapter for the Town's Comprehensive Plan Update
- established a Pollinator Pathway working group to promote new public and private pollinator gardens
